



Dots Banner

Materials:

Print out the following pages of 000000s and tape together to form a long banner. If possible, laminate the banner for durability.

Instructions:

2000 years ago, we were given a task, "Go and make disciples of all nations!" As children's leaders we focus on making disciples of children. How big is that task?

UNICEF statistics tell us that there are 2.3 billion children in the world. The numbers are mind-boggling. What does 2.3 billion children look like?

Display graphic of dots each representing 100,000 children. You might want to compare 100,000 to a town in your region. You may also want to colour in ten dots to illustrate one million children. A number that sounds so large is only a tiny fraction of 2.3 billion!

The task is enormous! To accomplish it will require multiplication, working together and the power of God in our ministries!
