Selfrespect


Obeying rules

Next, God made fish to swim in the sea. He made big fish and little fish. He made funny fish and pretty fish.


God made animals of all kinds. Some He made soft with fur. Others He made big and strong. Some He made very long!¹

Take a close look at the picture. What do you think is missing? What do you think God made next?






God made the first man and the first woman. He called the man Adam. The woman's name was Eve.

TRICK: to make people believe something that is not true.




Well, there is no one else like God. There never has been. There never will be.

That does not sound very nice, does it? But sometimes I act the same way. God calls this sin. That is why **Romans 3:23** says, 'All of us have sinned.'




Sin makes God's heart sad.


ould people ever learn to love and obey God like they should? What about the sin problem? It was like a big ugly spot on the heart of every person on earth. How could it be washed away?⁷

AMAZED: very, very surprised.




hen Jesus was 12 years old, His family went on a trip. They travelled far away from their town. They were going with many others to the temple to worship God.

Jesus grew strong and wise. Everyone liked Him very much.¹²




After Jesus was grown up, He went to hear a man teaching about God. The man's name was John.





The father went home and found his boy happy and well just like Jesus said!19




Another time, Jesus went to the house of a little girl who had died. Many people were there. Everyone was crying.


Before they knew it, all 5,000 people had eaten. There was even food left over!²⁵

HOLY SPIRIT: God's Spirit that lives inside of


everyone who follows Jesus.




The leaders decided to have Jesus killed.


Even then, Jesus was loving and good. Before He died, Jesus did something very special. He asked His Father to forgive the people who were nasty to Him.³¹

Jesus' followers were very sad. They missed Jesus so much.³³




But three days later, a wonderful thing happened! Once again, the ground began to shake. Then a bright shining angel came down from heaven. He rolled the great stone away!

One day, as Jesus was talking, His followers saw His feet lift off the ground. Up, up He went; right into the clouds!


Two angels came and said, Jesus has gone home to Heaven. He will come back someday in the very same way.'


There is one problem; sin. The sin in my heart makes me want to do wrong things. This keeps me from being God's child.
